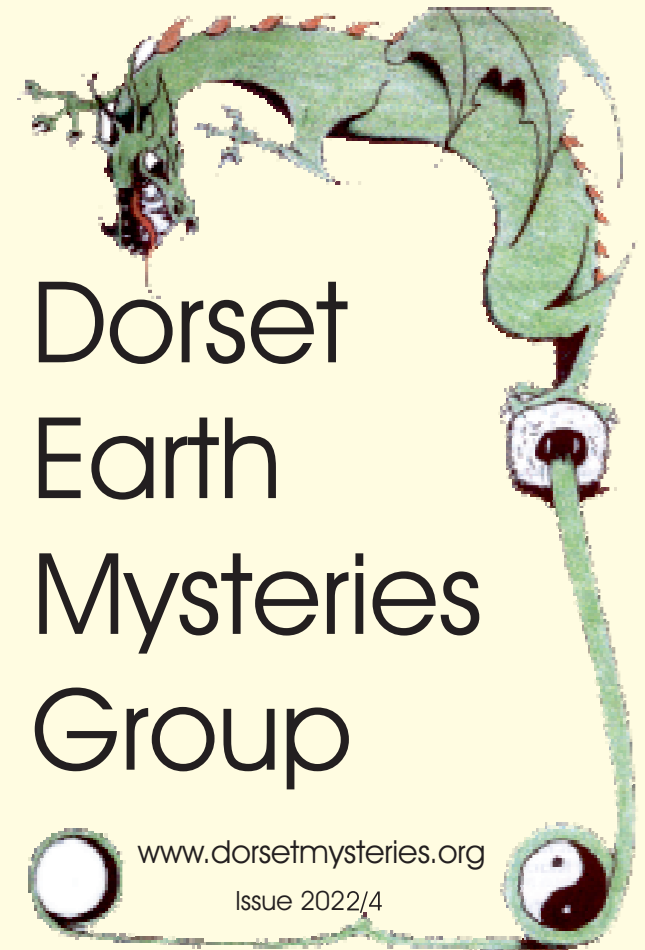

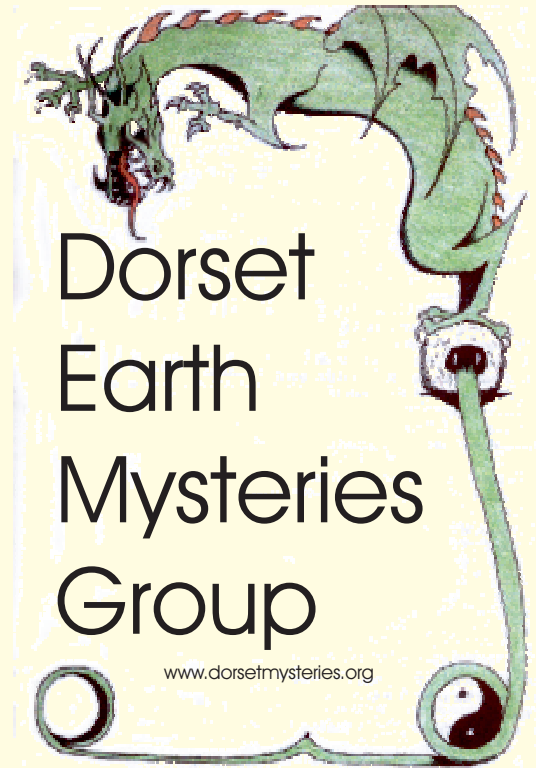
## Membership
